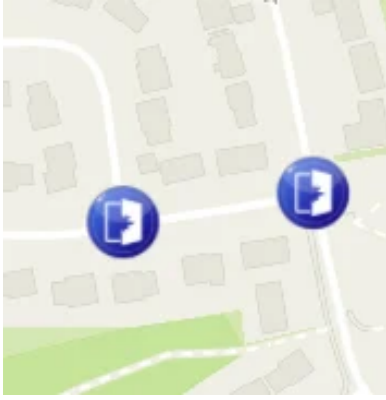
Kanata Golf Course – Rally – Sun Mar 8 – 1 PM

Break-in in Beaverbrook

A break-in and an attempted break-in occurred in the Pentland Place/Crescent area in late February.



Of concern is that this occurred at approximately 8 to 9 pm, when someone walked between homes to attempt to break in through the back of the house. In one case, someone was home and declined to attempt entry but left footprints in the snow. In the other phase, someone broke into a dark home by smashing a glass patio door and ransacked the bedroom for jewelry.

The message here is that **cameras and lighting for the back of homes are as important as the front, plus ensuring your home looks occupied when you are not there.**
